2. Presentations should not be less than two minutes long and not more than five minutes long and can be in the format of your choice. (e.g. Powerpoint, Prezi, MOVI)
3. All submissions will be deemed to be property of Island Heritage.
4. Any submissions deemed inappropriate by Island Heritage's Educational Grant Committee will result in the disqualification of the applicant.
5. Applicants will present their presentations to the Island Heritage Educational Grant Committee during the interview process and leave a copy of the presentation with the committee.

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SECTION IV: CRITERIA AND REQUIREMENTS CHECKLIST

CRITERIA

Student will demonstrate excellent academic skills, community involvement and leadership ability.

REQUIREMENTS

1. Student aged 16 - 25.
2. Completed application and letter.
3. Official transcripts for the past four years.
4. Proof of Caymanian nationality or Caymanian Status.
5. Letter of acceptance, conditional acceptance, or proof of continued enrollment in an accredited college or university.
6. Multimedia presentation. (for short-listed candidates only)

If this application is incomplete, inaccurate, not signed, or late it will not be considered. An application will not be processed unless all of the prescribed documents are submitted. Island Heritage will not follow up with applicants for missing documentation. Applicants should be prepared to attend an interview by the Island Heritage Educational Grant Committee in July. Failure to do so will be taken as a withdrawal from the process.

SECTION V: TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. The Island Heritage Educational Grant ("the Grant") is awarded annually. Its purpose is to provide financial support to a Caymanian high school/undergraduate student who is proceeding with full-time studies at an accredited college or university. A broad range of degree programmes/majors will be considered. To qualify, candidates must:
 - a. Be a Caymanian or Caymanian Status holder;
 - b. Aged between 16 - 25 years old at the time of application;
 - c. Hold a minimum of 3.0 Grade Point Average ("GPA") [American System or equivalent].
2. Applications will be considered from candidates who have either received a letter of acceptance/conditional acceptance from an accredited college or university or can show proof of continued enrollment in an accredited college or university.
3. The Grant funds, a total of US\$10,000 per academic year, are to be used in contribution towards the cost of tuition, accommodation, books or travel, related to full-time study
4. The Grant recipient will be selected by the Island Heritage Educational Grant Committee ("the Grant Committee"), comprised of members chosen by Island Heritage, which in its sole discretion may request further documentation or waive required conditions, on a case-by-case basis.
5. The Grant Committee may decline to award the Grant should it decide, in its discretion, that there are no suitable candidates.
6. The Recipient must complete the full term of study and is required to provide the Grant Committee with an official transcript after the awarded semester, demonstrating they have attained a minimum of 3.0 GPA.
7. The Recipient may re-apply for the Grant following completion of their awarded term of study.
8. Island Heritage reserves the right to withdraw the Grant and require the repayment of the Grant in whole or in part in the event of a failure to meet the terms and conditions of this agreement, or at any time if the work or conduct of the recipient is unsatisfactory, or the selected applicant becomes involved in any activity which places the prestige of the Grant in jeopardy.
